
34 of 39 UHCHI Culinary Apprentices are currently employed across 16 properties

Advice to Grow ICAPS

Win-win partnerships






Current Partnerships: CNA Program



Certified Nurse Assistant Training Program:

- 14-weeks long, consisting of 150 hours (100 hours of theory and 50 hours of clinical practice) in the basic principles and procedures of patient care
- Clinical experience is obtained in a long-term care setting (nursing home/hospital)
- Prepares students to give personal care to patients by helping them meet basic human needs for everyday living
- Approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health's Training and Technical Direction Unit for Long-Term Care Field Operations
- Upon successful completion of the program, graduates are assisted in taking the Illinois Nurse Aide Competency Examination
- * Instructors are Registered Nurses (RN), licensed in IL
- Currently over 12 Partners
